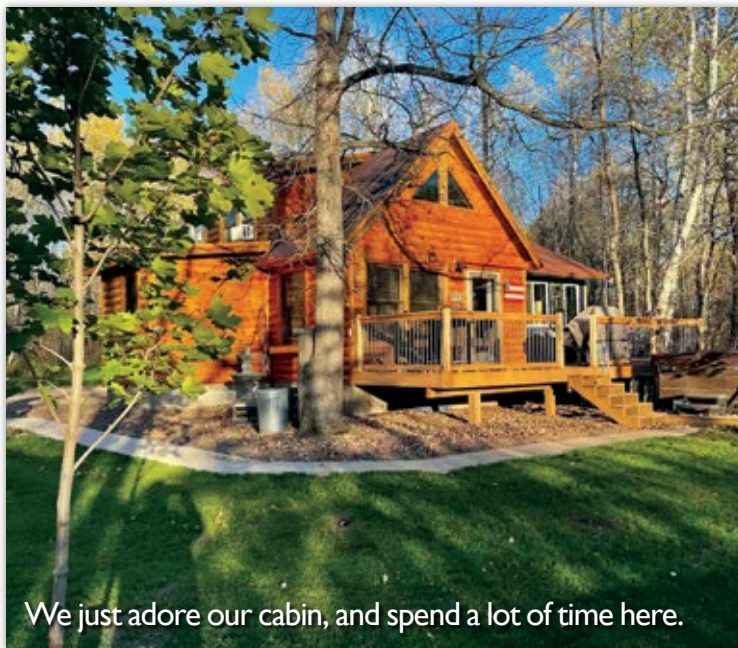


It was obvious to us right away that we were soulmates.
